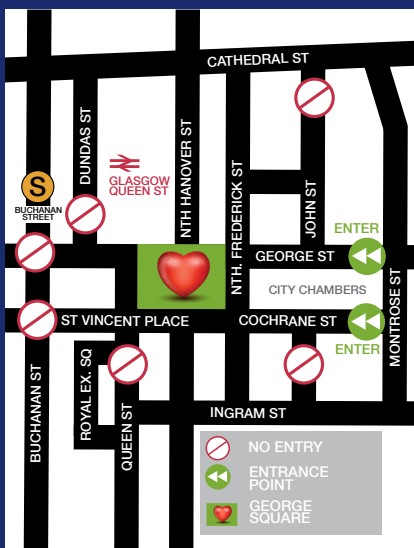
PARKING
